"The Lord watches over those who obey him, those who trust in his constant love." Psalm 33:18, Good News Translation

Isn't it enjoyable to watch a child grow? To see them change even after a few months. Perhaps, they are taller or their voice changes. Maybe you see more independence in them as they try to take on more responsibility or make some tough decisions on their own. As parents, grandparents, aunts, and uncles we see them as they are - kids who are really still dependent on us not ready to be on their own and supporting themselves. They still need to look to their mothers and fathers in trust and obedience.


As Christians, we are no different in our growth in Christ. It pleases God when we trust and obey; it also saves us a lot of anguish and despair when we decide to step out of the will of God for our life. I have experienced this first hand in my life. I want to grow in the grace God has so lavishly bestowed on my life. Don't you?

I have found that growth comes through trust and obedience - following Christ daily by listening and responding in faith. I have to wonder what would happen in one's Christian life if one would simply trust and obey God? How would you respond to a son or daughter? Would it not please you?

Abraham was a person who trusted and obeyed, and it pleased God. On a side note, starting in September, I will be preaching on "Living a life of trust and obedience." I will be using examples from the life of Abraham. Scripture reveals to you and I, Abram believed the Lord, and [God] credited it to him as righteousness (Gen. 15:6, NIV). What that verse means is that God blessed him because he trusted and obeyed.

Sometimes in our lives,
we are like Peter when he

we are like Peter when he saw Jesus walking on the water. Everything was fine until he took his eyes



off of Christ. When we start looking at the circumstances in our life or deciding when we can plan our own life, we start to sink. (Matt. 14). In my personal life, I have been guilty of taking the ball and running with it...leaving Christ behind. I usually find myself out of God's will, feeling discouraged and defeated.

Make it a point today to begin to read the Scripture verses on trust and obedience. Begin your day by asking God to help you follow the path that Christ has laid out for you. Then you will begin to see great things happen in your life.


To the members of Ontario United Methodist Church,
